Dear University of Miami School of Law Alumni:

As the Vice President for Regional Programs of the University of Miami Law Alumni Association and co-chair on the committee responsible for student recruitment and placement, I had an opportunity to speak with Therese Lambert, the Director of Student Recruiting, regarding how University of Miami Law alumni could assist in recruitment efforts.

Ms. Lambert said that she has quite a few resources in the alumni locally to aid in recruitment and retention of those students admitted to the law school. However, her alumni resources are scarce out of the area. She suggested that if each member of the alumni were to recommend two out of area alumni who would be willing to help her in recruitment, this would broaden her network tremendously. Even if those persons suggested are unable or unwilling, they may lead to the names of other alumni in that area who are willing to help.

The time commitment of those who volunteer would be minimal and might include only one or two activities per year. For example, they can volunteer to be on an alumni contact list, send an e-mail or call a few selected admitted students, or be involved in a reception for admitted students in their city. These types of alumni interactions can often be pivotal points in students' decision to attend the University of Miami School of Law or another law school.

Therefore, I ask that you please provide Ms. Lambert with the names of two alumni out of the area so that her office can begin to contact them.
