Required Forms:

Application for Diploma: You should have completed this form on MyUM. After Spring Break, check the Graduation bulletin board outside of Room 209 for accurate recording of your name and degrees for the program.

Regalia—cap, gown and hood: Complete the order for regalia online when you order your diploma.

Participation Card: Complete in the Office of the Dean of Students, Room 212. Indicate whether or not you will participate in the Ceremony.

Authorization and Release of the Certificate of Dean to the Bar: Complete in the Office of the Registrar, Room 210.

Regalia:
