The 2012 Summer Abroad Programs consist of two sessions each containing unique segments. Each student is required to enroll in both sessions. Students may enroll in either the London Summer Program or the Greece & Italy Program offered in Session 1. A single 3-credit course is offered in the Greece & Italy segment and two 3-credit courses are offered in the London Summer Program in Session 1. All students must also enroll in the London "Olympic" Program in Session 2. In the London Summer Program and the London "Olympic" Program one of two course offerings must be chosen. Each student must thus enroll in two 3-credit courses, one in each session, for a total of six credits.

In the London Summer Program, Session 1, and the London "Olympic" Program, Session 2, accommodations will be in UCL Schafer House Residential Hall in self-catered single room occupancy with washbasin in room and shared bathroom facilities in apartment-like clusters, with the exception of the English Countryside excursion in Session 1 which will be in hotel twin share rooms.

Housing is NOT included during the Intercession break – July 16-22, 2012.
