2012 Olympic Summer Abroad Program Experience the 2012 London "Olympic" Games Attend an Olympic Event

The University of Miami School of Law specifically designs its summer abroad programs to be the best located, longest, most comprehensive and most inclusive. An exciting array of fun destinations, weekend trips, a 4-day Aegean Cruise plus special events and guided tours as well as an entrance ticket to an Olympic Game are included at program expense.

The 2012 "Olympic" Summer Abroad Program consists of two sessions each containing unique segments. Each student is required to enroll in both sessions. Students may enroll in either the London Summer Program or the Greece & Italy Program offered in Session 1. A single 3-credit course is offered in the Greece & Italy Program and two 3-credit courses are offered in the London Summer Program in Session 1. The London "Olympic" Program in Session 2 also offers two 3-credit courses. In the London Summer Program and the London "Olympic" Program one of two course offerings must be chosen. Each student must thus enroll in two 3-credit courses, one in each session, for a total of six credits. Courses are designed to offer students an appreciation of the interrelationship of legal systems and cultural aspects that will help them become a successful attorney in the twenty-first century.

Our 2012 Summer Abroad Program gives the student the option of selecting any one of two exciting programs in Session 1 in combination with the London "Olympic" Program in Session 2. Students seeking the most travel in terms of both time and distance may opt for the Greece & Italy segment in Session 1 followed by the London "Olympic" Program segment in Session 2. Students who would prefer staying entirely in England may opt for the London Summer Program in Session 1 with the London "Olympic" Program segment in Session 2. Select by location, amount of travel, length of program, courses desired, variation in cost.

In the Greece & Italy Program housing double occupancy with breakfast daily and classroom facilities will be in Superior Tourist Class hotels arranged in cooperation with Contiki Holidays, the world's largest travel company for 18-35 year olds. In Greece some classes will be conducted aboard a cruise ship. In both London programs housing will be in self-catered single room clusters with shared bathrooms and kitchen at UCL Shafer House Residential Hall located within 10 minutes walking distance from UCL Faculty of Laws Bentham House in central London where classes will be conducted.

An 8-day break period, July 16-23, has been incorporated between sessions so that all students can explore other parts of Europe on their own or participate in our French Transition Intersession Optional Tour exclusively arranged and offered by Contiki Holidays. Students in the London Summer Program in Session 1 must make their own air travel arrangements one way to Nice, France, to participate. Students in the Greece & Italy Program will continue by coach from Venice to Nice. The break period does not otherwise include housing or transportation.

All courses are taught by faculty from the University of Miami School of Law and distinguished universities in the United Kingdom. All courses are taught in English.

Enrollment in each of our three segmented programs is strictly limited. Students are strongly encouraged to enroll early.
