Professor Sundby is a visiting professor from Washington & Lee University this fall teaching Substantive Criminal Law. In addition to teaching, he has served as Director of the Virginia Capital Clearinghouse, a clinic at W&L that advises lawyers appointed to represent capital defendants. To obtain a prosecutor's viewpoint of the criminal justice system, Professor Sundby took a leave of absence from teaching to prosecute cases as a Special Assistant United States Attorney for the Southern District of Florida. Professor Sundby is also an accomplished writer. His book, *A Life and Death Decision: A Jury Weighs the Death Penalty*, focuses on the human side of the decision by listening to how different jurors from the same case describe their jury's decision to impose a death sentence.
