Bruce Babbitt

Currently practicing law in Washington, D.C., **Bruce Babbitt** served as U.S. Secretary of the Interior from 1993 to 2001, as Governor of Arizona from 1978 to 1987, and as Attorney General of Arizona from 1975 to 1978. He is the author of ***Cities in the Wilderness: A New Vision of Land Use in America*** (Island Press, \$25.95), a brilliant and gracefully written important book that brings fresh thought to questions of how we can build a future we want to live in. A key architect of many environmental success stories, including the Florida Everglades restoration project, Babbitt reveals how broad restoration projects have thrived through federal-state partnerships and how their principles can be extended to other parts of the country. This will be a fascinating and especially relevant discussion in the aftermath of Katrina's destruction of the City of New Orleans.
