

The School of Law's wireless printing service is configured to run on Microsoft's Internet Explorer. In order to install wireless printers, users must access <http://webprint.law.miami.edu>. Note: While Internet Explorer is required for [webprint.law.miami.edu](http://webprint.law.miami.edu), it is not required for releasing jobs on <http://printjob.law.miami.edu>. In short Internet Explorer needs to be used only to install printers.

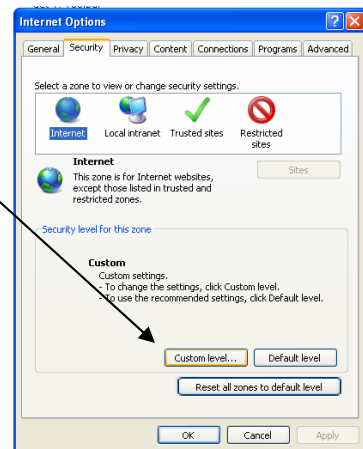
Recently, Microsoft has released Internet Explorer 7 to the general public. Internet Explorer 7 is being pushed out by Microsoft using their Automatic Updates application. Internet Explorer 7 includes more tools and settings used to better protect your system. One of those settings is that Internet Explorer 7 disables automatic running of ActiveX controls.

In order to install printers using Internet Explorer 7, ActiveX downloads must first be enabled on your browser.

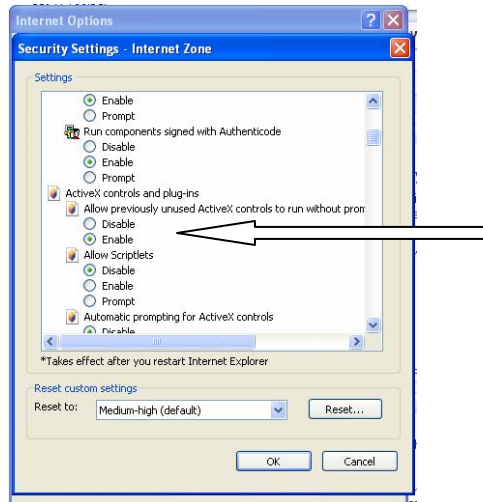
- On the **Tools** menu, click on **Internet Options**



- On the **Security** tab, click on **Custom level...**



- Scroll down to **ActiveX controls and plug-ins**. Under the first heading, **Allow previously unused ActiveX controls to run without prompt**, click **Enable**



- Then click **OK** and close down re-start your browser
- Go to <http://webprint.law.miami.edu> to install your desired printers
